National Testing Agency (NTA) has issued a Public Notice on 09 February, 2023 vide which information regarding online submission of applications and schedule for conducting CUET (UG) - 2023 in Computer Based Test (CBT) for the admission into Undergraduate Programmes in various Universities has been disseminated.


CUET (UG) – 2023 will provide a single window opportunity to students seeking admission in any of the Central Universities (CUs) or other participating organizations (including State Universities, Deemed and Private Universities) across the country.

For the Academic Session 2023-24, CUET (UG)-2023 will be conducted in the **Computer Based Test (CBT) mode** as per the details given below:

All the Heads of Govt Schools are hereby directed to comply with the directions/instructions issued by NTA vide aforesaid Public Notice. Special attention must be paid to the following points:

1. The CUET (UG) – 2023 will be conducted in 13 Languages under Section 1A-Languages.



2. Under Section 1B-Languages, There are 27 languages. Any of these languages may be chosen.
3. Under Section 2, there are 27 Domain specific subjects. A candidate may choose any subject as desired by the applicable University/Organization.
4. Section 3 is General Test. For any such undergraduate programme(s) being offered by Universities where a General Test is being used for admission.
5. Candidates can apply for CUET (UG) -2023 through the online mode only. Only one application is to be submitted by a candidate.
6. Students may be allowed to fill the online application through the school system.
7. Students must be informed about the instructions given in the Information Bulletin and the website <https://cuet.samarth.ac.in/> of NTA
8. Each Head of school will designate one Nodal Teacher in his/her school for CUET.
9. At District Level, a Help Desk will be established by the concerned DDE (District) with the contact Numbers. Members of Help Desk will be available round the clock and also arrange the Mock Test (CBT) for the practice of CUET (UG) – 2023.
10. EVGC will coordinate with the school and help the students in online submission of application and conducting the Mock Test (CBT) for the practice of CUET (UG) – 2023.
