1. The project must contain the information explaining various consumer duties and consumer rights with illustrations (drawn/sketched/pasted)



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2. The project must mention COPRA and Standardization of commodities like Hallmark, ISI etc.
3. The project must include TWO case studies on 'Consumer Exploitation' in the market and measures taken by them to seek redressal.

OR

Visit a CONSUMER COURT to understand the detailed proceedings of the various steps involved in seeking redressal. Discuss TWO case proceedings observed in the consumer court.

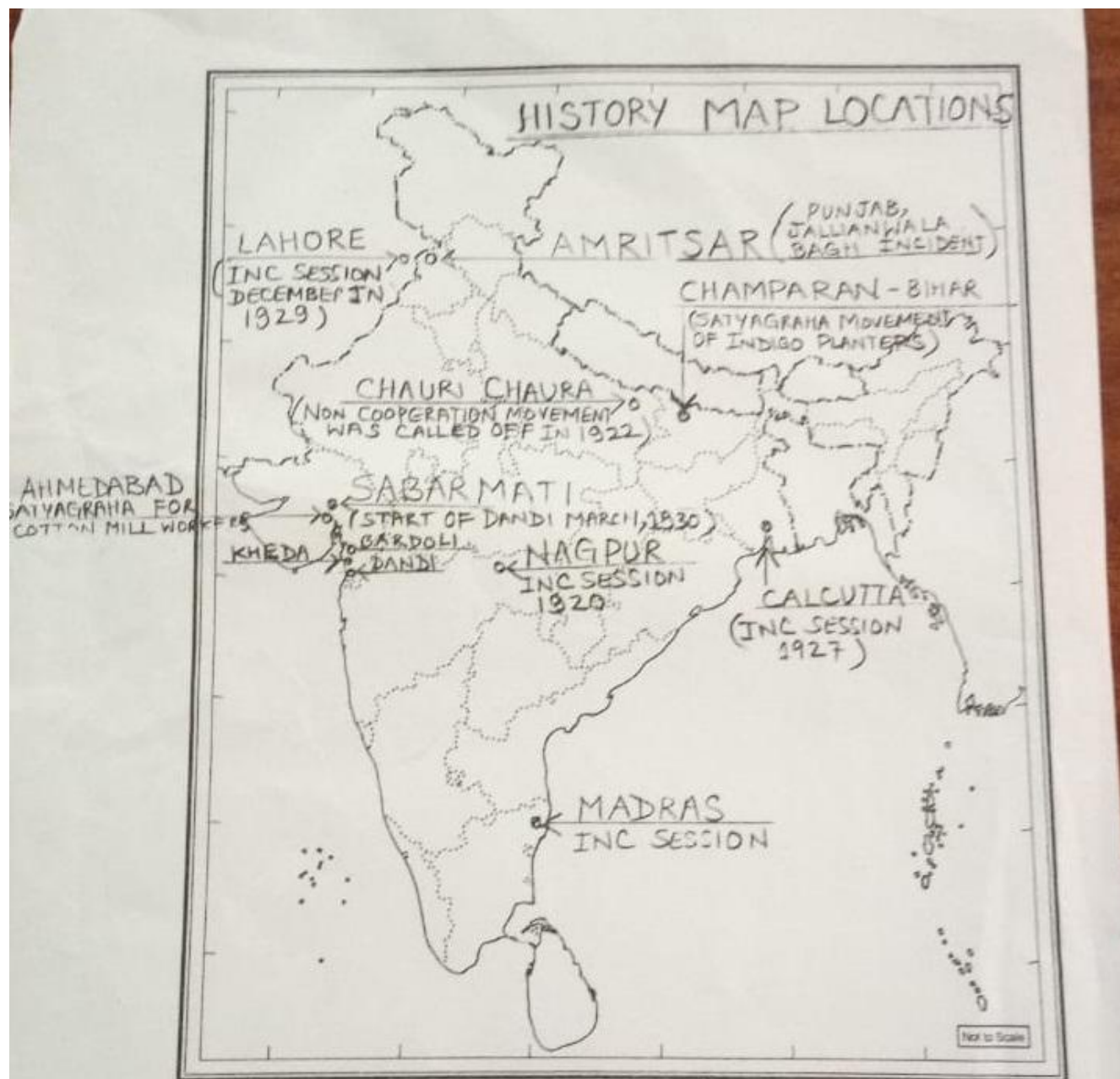


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BARDOLI - A Place where the NO TAX CAMPAIGN was started.
